*Building Blocks ...*

“ Jesus said, ‘Because of your hardness of heart, he wrote this commandment for you, but from the beginning of creation, ‘God made them male and female.’ ” Yes, this message from Christ invites us to reflect on the value and purpose of marriage in today’s world and to discover ways we can all help to strengthen marriages of those in our church, and among our families and friends.

Indeed, marriage is not celebrated privately in church, but before a gathering of family and friends because we all have a role to play in supporting and strengthening the union that we witness before our very eyes. Sometimes couples like to keep their marital struggles a secret but that’s probably the worst thing they can do. Sometimes, if a couple seeks help early enough when difficulties arise, they can rely on the wisdom of others who may have experienced the same or similar struggles in their own marriage or find strength and inspiration from Jesus’ words in the scriptures. That’s one of the reasons our marriage preparation program at Holy Redeemer relies on mentoring couples to assist young couples navigate the ins and outs of marital life. And if a separation or a divorce happens, we as the Christian community, must not seek to ostracize those whose marriage has fallen apart, but to minister to them with lovingkindness, gentleness and with a compassionate and listening heart.

In *Amoris Laetitia*, Pope Francis encourages us all to accompany and care for all those affected by separation and divorce in a nonjudgmental way. Remember, the church is likened to a field hospital that cares for the wounded; it is not a museum or a judicial court. It is the place where we all are invited to come (TODOS, TODOS, TODOS) to be lifted up when we have fallen and to receive divine grace to start walking again.

October is the Month of the Rosary

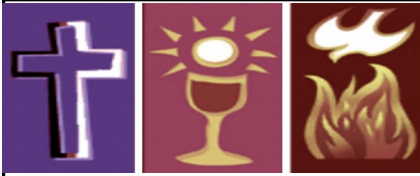
We will be reciting 1 decade of the Rosary before every Saturday/ Sunday Mass, as we did during the month of May.

- + 1st Reconciliation & 1st Communion - Grade 2/3
- + Confirmation - Grade 7 or older

**HOW TO REGISTER:** Complete an [online registration form](#) that can be found on our website [holyredeemersudbury.com](http://holyredeemersudbury.com) under “Sacraments”. We will contact you with further details of how this year’s sacramental preparation will take place.

⇒ Once a child is registered for 1st Reconciliation, he/she will automatically be included for 1st Communion.

**NOTE TO PARENTS:** You must provide a [Baptismal Certificate](#) if your child was NOT Baptized at Holy Redeemer Church. This is necessary prior to receiving any sacrament.

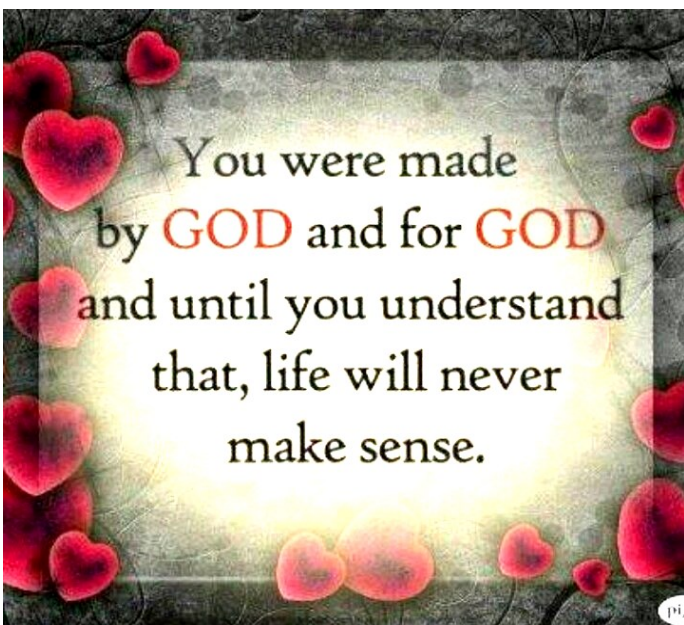
