Building Blocks ...

Our second reading today from the letter of James 2: 1-5 highlights the essential message that Pope Francis proclaimed at the last World Youth Day and many times afterward --- his message of *Todos, Todos, Todos! Everyone, Everyone, Everyone!*

What does he mean? He means that the Church of God is called to be open to EVERYONE having a place at the table! He means that NO ONE is excluded from God's plan of salvation! He means that when we see ourselves building walls instead of bridges, that we're trying to exclude rather than include, that we're trying to keep out rather than welcome, that we're trying to justify our prejudices and discriminations of others unlike ourselves rather that name our sin and repent.

James uses the example of the rich and the poor and how our reactions and behaviors might be different when faced with each. He reminds us that rejection of the poor is rejection of Christ, who became poor so that we might all become rich in faith, hope and love toward one another. He reminds us



that the Kingdom of God is much harder to enter into when we have built up rationalizations and justifications for why we are more worthy than someone else of God's saving love. So as we begin this Fall and head toward Advent, I invite each of us to reflect on how big our heart is and how large our embrace is for Todos, Todos, Todos! That is our building block for this week. --- Fr. Sam


