Building Blocks ...

"Listen! The wages of the labourers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, cry out, and the cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts." (James 5: 4) Today's second reading from the letter of James remind us how easily those who are migrants and refugees can sometimes be exploited and given the short end of the stick to satisfy those who feel entitled to treating others that way because of their wealth, status, or connections. James warns us that such a disregard for the marginalized and powerless will result in the harsh judgment of God upon those who think they can treat people any way that they want and get away with it.

September 29th has been designated by our church as World Day of Migrants and Refugees. Begun by St. Pius X in 1914, the day is a time to reflect on another element of our TODOS, TODOS, TODOS population: migrants and refugees. As Christians, we are called to safeguard the rights, dignity and opportunities for those fleeing corrupt government regimes, those whose lives or livelihoods are being threatened and have no option but to flee, irrespective of their religious affiliation or lack thereof. It is a reminder to us too of our own ancestors who may have sought to start a new life in a new country that offered them greater opportunity, equality, and freedom than their native lands. It's an opportunity for us to show others our Christian faith by putting into practice the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. It's an opportunity to hear and listen to their stories and to assist them in adapting to the culture, way of life, and the blessings which Canada has to offer.

Like the Lord, we must stand on the side of the poor, the migrant, the refugee and embody the Good News which Jesus proclaimed by his own preferential option for the poor and marginalized. ---- Fr Sam.

God walks with His people: Message of Pope Francis










Thursday October 3rd, 2024 At 12 Noon

Want to Become Roman Catholic or have missed Sacraments of Initiation along the way? (Baptism, Confirmation & Eucharist)

As we are revving up for the Fall, we would like to invite any adults or older children who are interested in becoming Roman Catholic to sign up online for a preparation program for the sacrament/s that you may not have yet celebrated. If you have not yet been baptized, please sign up for baptism. If you have already been baptized in another Christian denomination, please sign up for Eucharist and Confirmation.

If your child attends Pius XII and is in grade **four, five or six**, there will be an in-school formation program for them in January. We would however like you to enroll your children now by asking you to complete the online sacramental forms available at **holyredeemersudbury.com**

1st Reconciliation & 1st Communion – Grade 2 or Older Confirmation – Grade 7 or older

HOW TO REGISTER: Complete an <u>online registration form</u> that can be found on our website holyredeemersudbury.com under "Sacraments". We will contact you with further details of how this year's sacramental preparation will take place.

Once a child is registered for 1st Reconciliation, he/she will automatically be included for 1st Communion.

NOTE TO PARENTS: You must provide a <u>Baptismal Certificate</u> if your child was <u>NOT</u> Baptized at Holy Redeemer Church. This is necessary prior to receiving any sacrament.
