## **Building Blocks**

In today's gospel, we hear Jesus commanding his disciples, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 28:19) This commissioning is the first time that we hear the trinitarian formula invoked by Christ in the scriptures. And while the word 'Trinity' is never expressly used in the scriptures, Jesus often speaks of the interplay and interrelationship between Father and Son, Father and Spirit, and the Son and Spirit, in his discourses to the disciples. It's this interrelationship, distinctiveness, and concomitant unity within the One Godhead that we celebrate today.

We also celebrate our own participation in the life of the Trinity through our baptismal consecration. Indeed, it is the baptismal grace that is nourished within us each week, as we celebrate the Eucharist, that enables us to take up the mission of the church, to the honor and glory of the most Holy Trinity. When we take up the mission of the church, then we need to do so, in keeping with the example of the Holy Trinity. That means working together as the People of God with one common purpose: extending the nets of God's kingdom. That means appreciating and encouraging the various talents and skills of every baptized member of the church for the greater glory of God. That means striving for unity

of mind and spirit as we work together to advance God's reign, not only in our own lives, but in the lives of all who hear and embrace the Gospel message. That also means excluding no one!

All are called to be a part of God's kingdom! No one is beyond God's love! That means we have to be dynamic and artful in the way we profess and live out our faith, again in likeness to the dynamism and artful expression of the Holy Trinity, whose movements of grace and action take on a beautiful choreography that is able to attract all to union with the Holy and the Divine. Our building block this week then, is to emulate the beauty and artfulness of the Holy Trinity in our lives. --- Fr Sam




All are warmly invited to join us next Sunday, as we celebrate our pastor on the occasion of his Silver Jubilee!
