s we celebrate this Pentecost, may we each catch the Spirit, and inflamed by its fire, move lovingly in our world.

Building Blocks



In our first reading this weekend, we hear, "Suddenly, from heaven, there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues as of fire, appeared among them and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages as the Spirit gave them ability." (Acts 2: 2-3) Wow! What a dramatic entrance of the Holy Spirit in the hearts and minds and souls of the disciples and Mary! Such a dramatic and life-changing entrance was meant to convey some important truths about the Holy Spirit to the fledgling church and to all of us, the members of the Church today!

First, the Spirit of God is a God of surprises! We can never anticipate where or when or how the Spirit may make her presence known. The Spirit chooses her own time and place! Remember, God has no gender, and so, the Spirit can often be thought of as a feminine dimension of God, who urges us to be creative, to be life-giving, to be transforming of our own and others' lives.

Secondly, we can't ever try to control the Holy Spirit! Wind can't be captured! There's no particular origin and we can never know how long it will last, how forceful it will be, and when it will dissipate! Wind stirs things up! Wind unearths things we might not have notice beforehand. Wind against our bodies can also be refreshing and urge us to run like the wind! Ask any runner!

Thirdly, the Spirit of God is like a blazing fire! --dynamic, ever-changing, and noticeable by all who are in its vicinity! When the Spirit of Fire is in our hearts, it produces a zeal for spreading the Good News unlike anything we've ever experienced before!

Fourth, the Holy Spirit enables us to communicate to those who have not yet heard or embraced the Gospel of Christ in the best ways possible! She gives us encouragement to speak God's truth, to use the right words for the particular audience that we have, and to spread God's church far and wide! Is it any wonder then that the Easter Season culminates in the Great Solemnity of Pentecost! Let the Spirit flow through you and out of you and you will never be the same! --- Fr Sam


