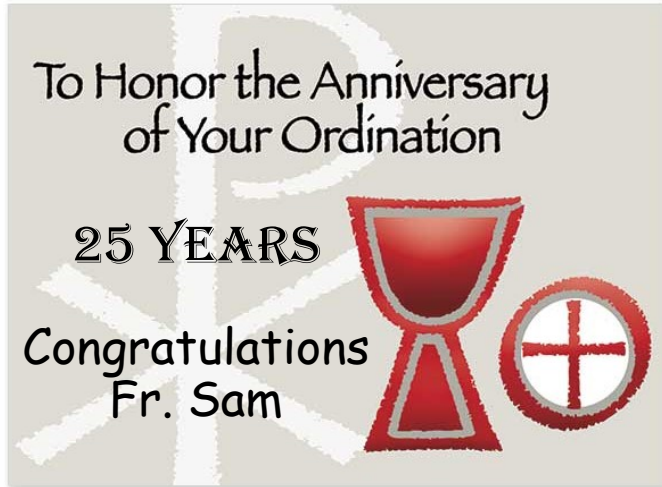

Join us as We Celebrate



May the Lord in His goodness richly bless you. May He bring you peace of mind and heart. May He give you joy as you celebrate your 25th Ordination Anniversary. Congratulations on your Silver Jubilee!

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, more traditionally known as Corpus Christi Sunday. The Feast of the Precious Blood had traditionally been celebrated on July 1st. As a Missionary of the Precious Blood, one of the reasons why I was ordained on July 3rd was because it was the closest weekend to July 1st that year. The two celebrations were combined under Pope Benedict XVI. The new title for the solemnity unites the two aspects of Jesus' redemption: his body broken and crucified and his blood outpoured for the forgiveness of our sins. It reminds us of the last supper in which Jesus' body and blood became present in the bread and wine for the first time and invites us to reflect on what we do, in memory of Him, until he comes again in glory.

Because the Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life, the more we know what's happening in the mass and open ourselves up to the liturgical movements in the mass, the greater that Eucharist will impact our lives as we leave the doors of the church every weekend. So this weekend, we will look at the various parts of our Eucharistic celebration so that we may gain a greater understanding and appreciation for what we do, why we do it, and how we do it.

The liturgy that we celebrate on Sundays doesn't just happen without any planning. There is a lot of prep time spent months before the actual mass is celebrate to coordinate music selection, homilies, power point presentations, liturgical art and environment, the Time Traveller program, special collections, and other rites that occur during the mass. The reason for this extensive preparation is so that the various liturgical movements in the mass are choreographed to produce a beautiful "dance" to the honor and glory of God each week. Just as our liturgical ministers prepare for the mass, so too, all of us should prepare for the mass by reading the scriptures ahead of time, to reflect on what our venial sins may be and for which we would like to repent, and to be prepared to open ourselves up to whatever the Holy Spirit may want to inspire in us during the Eucharistic Celebration. When we approach the mass with the intent of fully and actively participating according to our particular circumstances, we will look forward to the next celebration with eagerness each week. --- Fr. Sam
