### Building Blocks ...

In our second reading this weekend from the Letter of James, we're asked to consider the following: "If a brother or sister is without clothing and lacks daily food, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace; keep warm and eat your fill,' and yet, you do not supply their bodily needs, what is the good of that? So faith, by itself, if it has no works is dead." (James 2:15-17)

Yes, part of our commitment to Todos, Todos, Todos is our responsibility to see the blessings of our own lives as graces that we can bestow generously on those who need them most. For this weekend, the groups that we're called to focus on are **the homeless**, **those not making enough financially to support themselves and their families**, **and those who perhaps are suffering from mental illness and are unable to hold down a steady job**. Called to put our faith into action, our initial response should be one of treating the other with respect and dignity and non-judgment. Our faith response needs to be one of patiently listening and then discerning how best to meet their needs with the resources we've been given and also, by referring to public resources that are available to assist in various ways, if available.

Part of our responsibility then is to not ignore the need in front of us but to do something about it, if we can. Part of our responsibility is to see if we can assist, in any way, in bringing about a change for the better in another's life. Sometimes just giving someone money isn't the best response. Sometimes, giving out gift cards is the way to go, or helping the person to access food or clothing banks in the city. Sometimes just giving someone a ride is what is most helpful. Faith not put into practice is not real faith at all. Authentic faith comes from putting what we believe into practice ---putting our pedal to the metal and accompanying one another along the way to the Kingdom of Love, Justice and Peace. No one should ever be left behind! TODOS, TODOS, TODOS! All are welcome to be a part of God's holy Church and to be servants of the Most High Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! All are worthy of being seen as made in the image and progressing toward the likeness of God. So this week's building block is our faith put into action! --- Fr. Sam
